GAPS & CHALLENGES

- · Limited disability & elderly data; gaps in education, employment, and access to services.
- High GBV prevalence (46%+) undermines safety and wellbeing.
- 1 in 4 youth not in school or work; migration
- Poverty and inequality concentrated in rural areas.

GOVERNANCE & MANAGEMENT

- Parliament: 5 elected women; quota ensures 10% minimum.
- · Women hold 31% of board chairs, 36% of directorships, 40% of CEO roles, ~41% senior management.
- DDP councils mandate women and youth inclusion.
- · Every village has Sui o Tamaitai alongside Sui o Nuu - securing women's voice in governance.

COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

- Though village representative iniatives- Komiti o Tina drive health, prevention, environment initiatives.
- Women's committees and churches anchor wellbeing and faith leadership.
- Through DDP-50%+ of programme beneficiaries are women and girls, 5,000+ women engaged in GEDSI initiatives.

Highlights - 2025

- \$1 Million Tala Programme (DDP)- 4,000+ projects delivered 134,334 people reached across Samoa
- Health- 2,045 households surveyed, 300+ villages mobilised in dengue clean-ups, 20,000 people engaged, including 250 women's committees (Jul-Sep 2025)
- · Youth Flagship Achievements- Youth in Governance: Youth now have a seat in all 51 District Councils through the DDP, Youth Advisory Board - Established 2024; members recognized at UNGA 2025 and Commonwealth Youth Awards, Creative Enterprises, Crisis & Climate Action - 2,000+ youth mobilised in dengue response; leaders in clean-ups & climate-smart initiatives, Youth Celebrations - Youth Day, Youth Week, International Youth Day platforms for leadership & innovation (e.g. Paddle for Progress Regatta).
- Children- ECD Framework launched (2025), 600+ reached through rollout; 24 champions mobilised, Hosted Pacific Regional FCD Forum & Frontliners Summit
- Women & Girls- Represent 50%+ of beneficiaries
- Disability- 494 people reached through social protection & **GEDSI** programmes

STATUS OF WOMEN

- Women = 49% (~225.000)
- Labour force participation

36% (vs men 62%); female unemployment 7.8%.

- · Girls outperform boys in school/tertiary; STEM gaps persist.
- · Life expectancy: women 74 vs men 70.
- Skilled birth attendance >90%; NCDs disproportionately affect women.
